Introduction

Liaison Financial's High Cost Tariff Excluded Device (HCTED) reimbursement review looks at the purchases of an NHS organisation's HCTED items, completing a full reconciliation of the purchase of qualifying devices and where reimbursement can be made.

NHS organisations must use the correct code for HCTED reimbursement. Where the incorrect code is used, an organisation may miss out on automatic reimbursement.

Our reviews identify these errors and assist organisations to manually reclaim for high-cost devices on a specific return basis.

Results to date:

- In 2023/24, our HCTED reviews found an average of £134,000 in reimbursement per NHS organisation, despite an increase in NHSE automatic adjustments.
- One Trust saved £750,896 in reimbursements over a two-year period.
- Ongoing recommendations made to help accurate HCTED reimbursement going forward.

HCTED reimbursement claims are time-restricted and **must** be claimed either within the financial year or soon after it ends, so act now to avoid losing any claims relating to 2024/25.
